



GET YOUR USCG CAPTAIN'S LICENSE IN JUST 3 WEEKENDS WITH NO COAST GUARD EXAM

Masters 100 Gross Ton Upgrade License

Mariners School offers qualified Captains a path to upgrade their OUPV license to a Master level license. The Masters License allows the holder to operate uninspected vessels as well as inspected vessels. The United States Coast Guard requires any Captain operating an inspected vessel certified to carry more than 6 paying passengers to be a holder of this license.

There are 2 different levels an OUPV Licensed Captain may qualify for. They are the Master Inland or Master Near Coastal. The amount of Sea Service and size of vessels you have operated will determine the license you are eligible for. Masters licenses are rated by tonnage at 25GT (gross tons), 50GT, or 100GT. The tonnage your license will be approved for will be determined by the size of vessel you have operated in the last three years.

Master Inland:

Requirements for this license include successful completion of Mariners School 24 hour USCG approved course and exam as well as sea service. For Master Inland, the requirement is 360 days of Sea Service since age 15; 90 of those days must have been gained in the last three years.

Master Near Coastal:

Requirements for this license include successful completion of Mariners School 24 hour USCG approved course and exam as well as sea service. For Master Near Coastal, the requirement is 720 days of Sea Service since age 15; at least 90 of those 720 days must be in the last three years; 360 of those 720 days must be outside the Boundary Lines.

Additional Requirements:

- Must be at least 19 years old
- A physical exam if more than 3 years have elapsed since the last exam
- Drug test unless enrolled in an USCG approved random drug testing program for at least 60 of the last 185 days, and did not fail or refuse to participate in a chemical test for dangerous drugs.
- US Citizenship

Refund policy
